The Creative Curriculum

Throughout the month of June we will be wrapping up our tree study and beginning exercise study. We need your help to get our study moving! If you can, we'd love your help in gathering items to investigate. We'll need many different objects and pictures related to exercise. Below is a list of suggested items, but you may also send others not on the list that you think may add to our exploration. Please label all items with your name so we can return them to you at the end of our study. We promise to take good care of them.

Equipment/objects- small child-safe trampoline, balls, hand weights (up to 2lbs), hippity-hop ball, stretching bands, exercise mats, hula hoops, jump ropes, scarves for dancing, Frisbees, and dance music.

Pictures- walking/running, climbing, dancing, gymnastics, tennis, sledding, swimming, volleyball, and lifting weights.

At home you can talk with your child about exercise and do a few exercises with your child each day. Point out when you notice people in your community exercising. Help your child keep a daily exercise chart. Create a list together of your family's favorite exercise. As you read books with your child, notice and talk about the character's physical movements. Thank you for playing an important role in our learning.
