A Message from Terry

As some of you may know in July of 2017 I was diagnosed with trigeminal neuralgia. Most people have never heard of it but it is listed as the worse pain known to mankind. It was like an electric shock that went from my ear, through my teeth to my tongue. The pain happened about 100 times a day. The doctors treated it with seizure medication that had awful side effects. In November of 2018 I decided to have brain surgery to hopefully relieve me from the pain and let me stop taking the medication that made me miserable and almost killed me. Well when they got in there they realized it wasn't being caused by what they suspected so it became a much bigger problem. The surgery was a success as far as getting rid of the pain but it left me with extreme double vision and the right side of my face and mouth completely numb. The numbness is permanent but the double vision can be partially corrected. That gets to the reason I'm telling you all this... They are going to fix it on November 26th and they have warned me that I will feel fine but will have a blood red eye for about 30 days. I didn't want you all to wonder... "What happened to her?"
