### Creative Curriculum

Currently we are focusing on our building study. At home, you can study your house or apartment building with your child. What materials were used to build it? How many floors or stories does it have? How many rooms, windows, and doors does it have? Don't forget the basement if you have one. How old is your home? Who built it? What are its dimensions? Talk with your child about the buildings that you see together. Keep a list of the buildings that interest your child. Help your child investigate questions similar to the ones we mentioned above. At the end of the study, we will have a special event to show you what we've learned. Thank you for playing an important role in learning.
