*Illness in your family

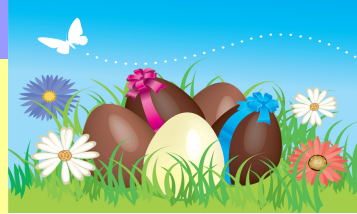
*Crisis within your family
