

## -NEWS AT THE HAVEN-

We are kicking off the summer with our gardening study. We will use children's questions as the basis of our investigations and learn how to plan and care for a garden, how gardens grow, who helps gardens grow, how gardens help people and the environment, and how to harvest a garden. At home you can take walks around your neighborhood with your child to look for gardens. Examine any gardens you find and talk about the different types of plants they contain. If you are unable to find a garden in your area, visit a local garden center to look at plants and gardening supplies. Invite your child to share what he or she is learning about gardens by caring for a plant in your home or garden. Herb plants such as basil and chives are generally easy to find and care for, but feel free to choose whatever kind of plant you'd like.
