We are sincerely thankful to all of our children and their families! We appreciate your love & support!

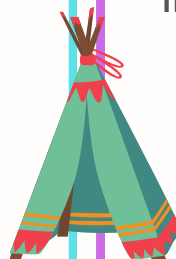
